I hope all of you have been enjoying this summer. As you know we are dark for the summer so this report is very short. Our only meet-




ing will be a stated meeting for August. Congratulations to the winner of last month's stated meeting Hawaiian shirt night. Be sure to come to dinner and stated this month.

### PROCLAMATION

#### CONSTITUTION OBSERVANCE MONTH
